



Meeting Minutes for August 2, 2006

At the State Fair Office, Mechanicsville, VA

The meeting was called to order at 9 a.m. by President Lin Diacont with the following people in attendance: Lorene Blackwood, Gwynn Hubbard, Kathy Duncan, Annette Pelliccio, Joel Koci, Lizzy Pine, Bill Bonwell, Sylvia Wright, Cary Gouldin, and Jeff Miller.

Executive Director's report: Jeff reported on the news releases that had been sent out since the last meeting and the responses in the non-daily newspapers, which is way ahead of last year's usage. Jeff reported that the State Corporation Commission had approve a service mark application for "The Virginia Garden Festival" (file #7926) which provides exclusive use protection of the name in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Financial Report: see attached copy.

Budget: Cary requested that each committee project line item amounts for their committee for the 2007 budget, which must be done by November.

Communications: Sylvia reported on responses to news releases that she has been sending out and requested everyone to continue providing her with information for the VGIC email Bulletin and News Updates. She is negotiating a deal with the VIRGINIA REVIEW to publish an article on the Virginia green industry, but they have some very stringent publishing requirements. (See attached report)

State Fair: Gwynn requested extra help to unload plant material when it arrives for the Horticulture Gardens at the State Fair. Donations will be arriving on September 23 and 24 and setup will be on the 25th. Sylvia will do an article about the plant sale and an email will be sent out to the members requesting extra help with the plant sale on Monday after the Fair.

Ag and Forestry Day at the State Fair: Lorene discussed plans for this event on October 6 at the Fair. Governor Tim Kaine is scheduled for a guided tour of the Virginia World at 10:30 a.m., which will be showcasing Virginia agriculture commodities and then there will be a luncheon with the Governor.

Virginia Garden Festival: Rick Baker reviewed plans for the first annual Virginia Garden Festival which will be held on Saturday, September 16 in conjunction with the Lewis Ginter Botanical Garden Fall Plant Sale. Mark Viette will be doing his Saturday morning gardening radio show for the event, along with Mike McGrath who is the former editor-in-chief of *Organic Gardening* magazine and host of the nationally syndicated public radio show "*Your Bet Your Garden*". Rick indicated the event should break-even.

Maymont Flower & Garden Show – there was some discussion about speaker sponsorship at the next show, but there is some question as to the viability of the show and a decision will be made later when we have more information on the show and program.

Being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:30 pm to the Richmond Raceway Complex to setup the VGIC "Ask the Experts" booth for the Virginia Agribusiness Food Festival.
